# **Step by Step Guide for Activity Organisers**

To participate in the scheme, activity organisers should take note of the following 4 steps when organising an activity under the Digital Badges Scheme.

- 1.) **Choose the Digital Badge(s)** which aligned with the duration, the nature and the intended learning outcomes of the activity. (Please refer to <u>General Principles of Awarding the Digital Badge</u>
- 2.) **Promote the activity with additional remarks** about the Digital Badges Scheme and the type of Digital Badge(s) participants will receive after completing the activity. On the enrolment form, staff can create a selection for participants to choose whether they would like to publish the Digital Badge records on the THEi website: <u>Digital Badges</u>

  <u>Scheme Records of Achievement</u>. The activity organiser can then relay the information to the learning advisor for updates.
- 3.) The activity organizer can **upload the attendance records** with the template provided (<u>Activity Attendance Form</u>) on <u>MyPortal</u>: Activity > Other Achievement > Upload. The activity organizer can send a copy of the activity attendance form to the Learning Advisor from LCDI for record keeping.
  - \*Staff can obtain access right from ITSD to upload attendance records on MyPortal.
- 4.) Activity organizer should **inform participants about the updates** on MyPortal and the Digital Badge(s) they have earned.

## A: <Choosing a suitable Digital Badge for the activity>

### **Descriptions of the 6 Digital Badges**



Activities which enabled participants to learn professional knowledge and skills required in an industrial setting

## Informed and Professionally Competent (IPC)



Activities which required participants to take initiative in gaining knowledge and skills in enhancing academic and personal development

**Independent Learners (IDL)** 



Activities that equipped participants with critical and analytical thinking skills that lead to solving existing problems

## **Problem Solvers (PS)**



Activities that required participants to demonstrate high level of communication skills as effective communicators through various communication channels

### **Effective Communicators (EC)**



Activities that enabled participants to learn about the pressing issues and ethical codes in the industry with social, economic, global implication

## Professionally, Socially and Globally Responsible (PSG)



Activities that enabled participants to develop a positive mindset, show empathy towards others as well as be an adaptive person in coping with the new challenge

### Positive and flexible (PF)

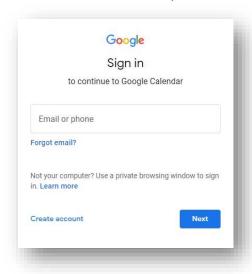

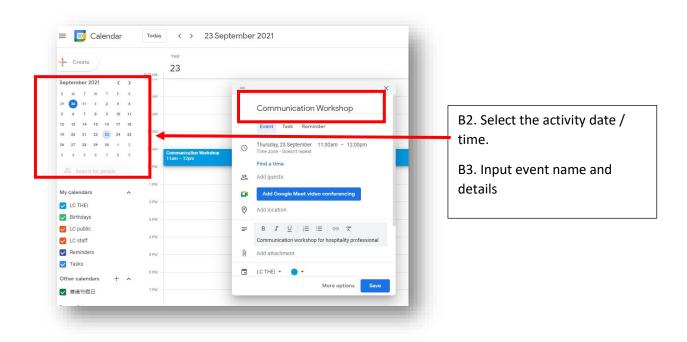

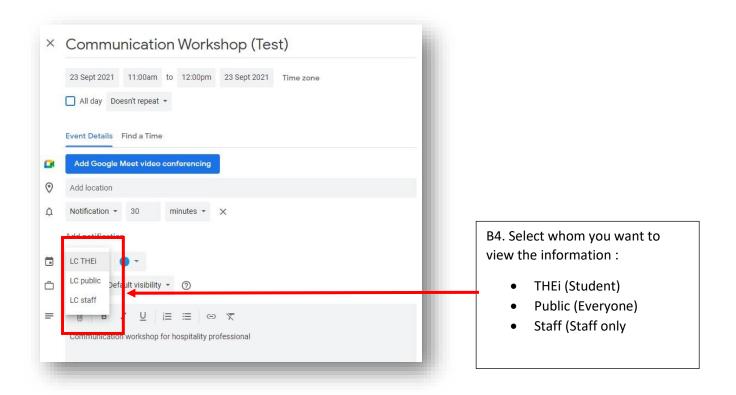
# B1. Upload activity to News & Events

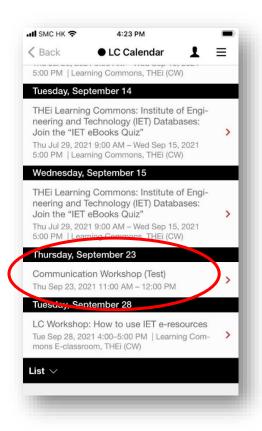
Create an event through google calendar > THEi Mobile App

- Type in your departmental username and password to log in



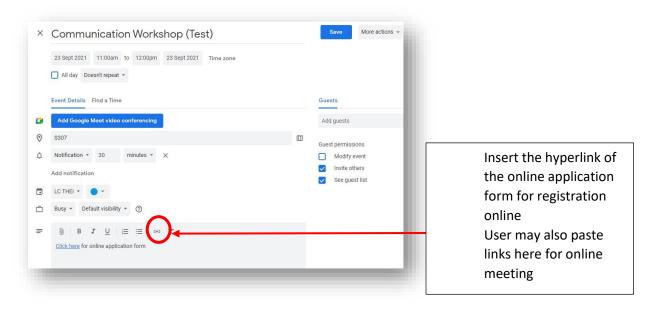




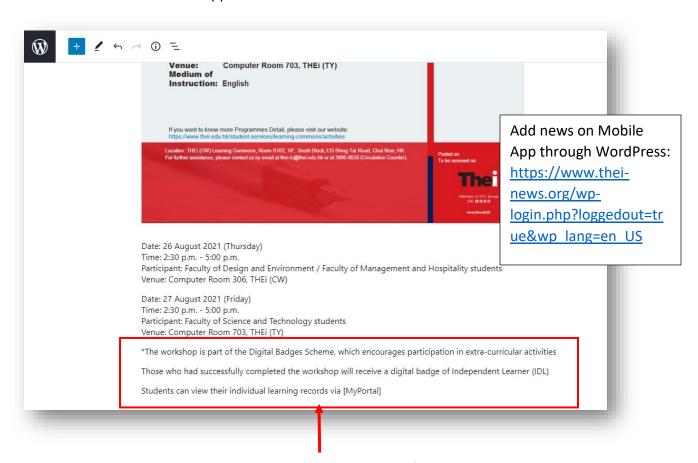


B5. This is how the activity will appear on the Mobile App > News & Events > Events > (Faculties/school/OUs) Calendar

### B7. Edit news on THEi Mobile App

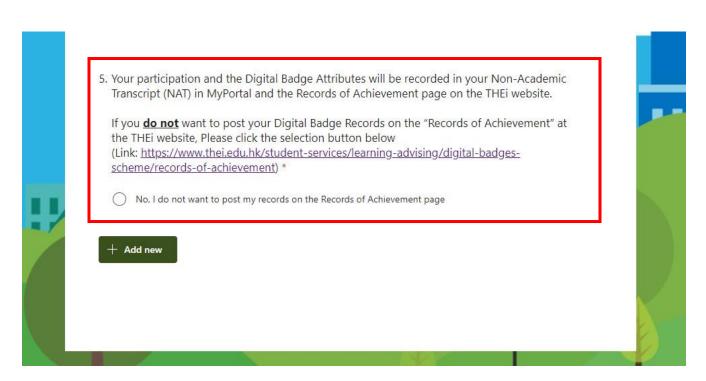


The activities organiser can include a remark in the promotion, to inform the student that the activity is included in the Digital Badges Scheme and the type of badge(s) they can earn.

### C. < Recommendation for the activity registration on E-form>



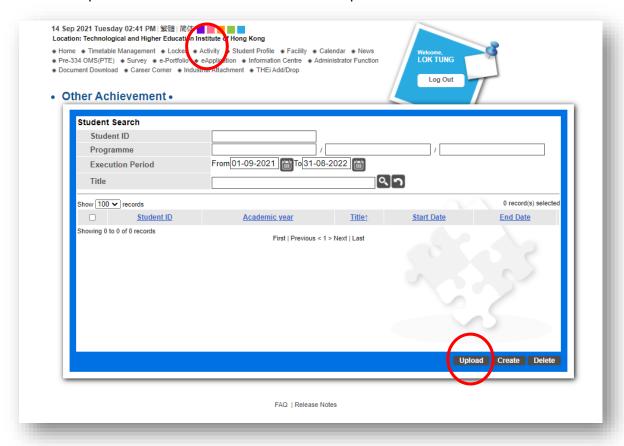

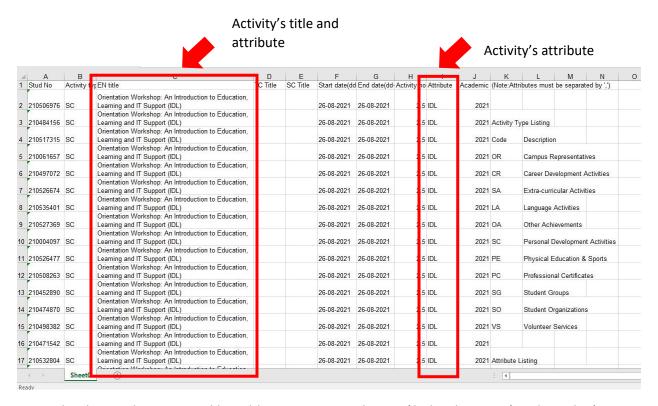
- D1. Open: Activity > Other Achievement
- D2. Select "Upload" to download the attendance template in Excel format



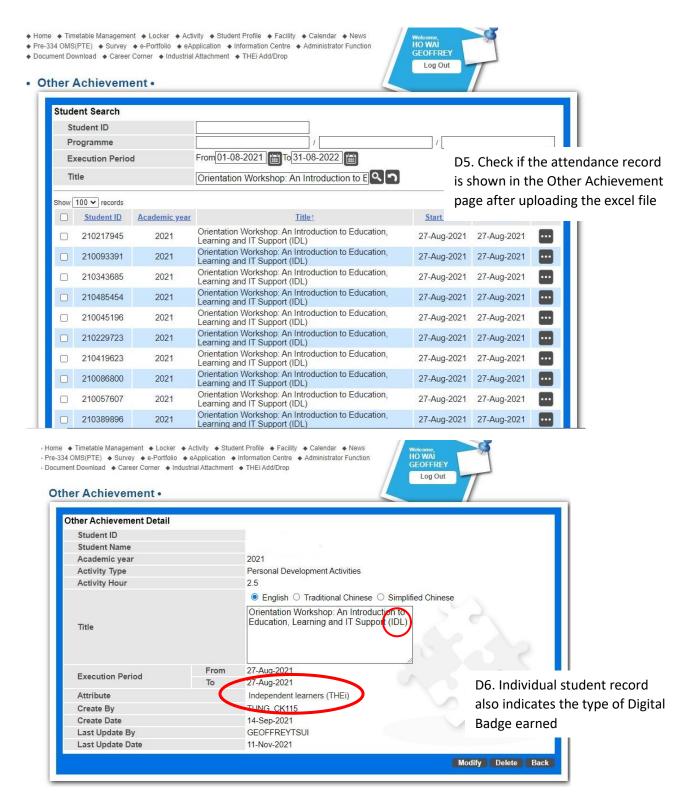
D3. Complete the attendance template while indicating the attribute(s)



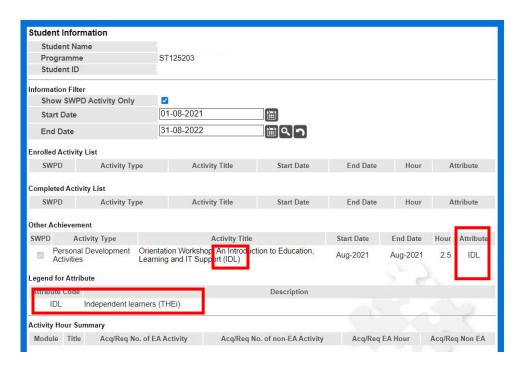
Select the appropriate attribute in abbreviations from the "Attribute Listing" on the template
