

Pet-friendly Guidelines in THEi Chai Wan Campus (“CW Campus”)

For Programme Trial Day on 23rd and 24th May 2025 (the “Period”)

1. 1/F Podium of CW Campus will be designated as the Pet Zone during the Period, the opening hours of the Pet Zone is from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. THEi reserves the rights to change the opening hours and/or to close the whole or any part of the Pet Zone without prior notice.
2. Only domesticated pet dogs and cats (“Pet(s)”) are permitted to enter CW Campus. Other animals are not allowed to enter CW Campus.
3. Pet owners shall keep their Pets in a pet stroller or carry bag with properly closed cover and do not expose their Pets in any area other than the Pet Zone, except guide dogs.
4. Pet owners shall ensure their Pets under control effectively in order not to cause nuisance or injury to individuals and other Pets.
5. Pet owners must maintain cleanliness and hygiene on the THEi Chai Wan Campus. If pets need to defecate, pet owner is required to take them to the designated Pet Waste Station and immediately clean up the pet’s excrement using a sealed bag, container or tool, and dispose of it in the “Pet Waste Collection Bin”. THEi offers basic pet cleaning supplies such as pet pee pads and wet wipes. For more details, please visit Programme Information and Gift Redeem Booth.
6. According to the Food Businesses requirements (Cap 132X), dogs should not be allowed to enter food premises, except guide dogs.
7. All Pet(s) must be fully vaccinated in compliance with statutory requirements.
8. Under the Dangerous Dogs Regulation (Cap 167D), “Fighting Dogs”, other classified as “Known Dangerous Dogs” should not enter CW Campus.
9. Dogs weighing 20kg or above are required to be on leash not longer than 1.5 meters in length and must be securely muzzled.
10. Pet owners shall be solely responsible for any injuries to their own Pet(s) and/or for any injuries to individuals and/or other pets and/or for damage and/or loss of property and/or belongings of others at CW Campus. THEi shall not be responsible and do not assume any liability for any such injuries, damage to and/or loss.
11. If Pet owners are found to be in breach of any of these guidelines and/or their Pet(s) is determined as a threat and/or a disturbance to others, staff of THEi or campus security shall have the right to request Pet owners and their Pet(s) to leave CW Campus immediately.

12. In case of disputes, the decision of the THEi will be final and binding.
13. The Chinese version of these Guidelines are for reference only. In case of discrepancies between the provisions of the Chinese version and the English version, the English version shall prevail.
