- 1 Students of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Culinary Arts and Management are allowed to take “GEE5102 Impact of Contemporary Design on Society” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from the Year-1 and Year-3 entry cohorts of AY 2018/19. The students admitted before the above cohorts are not allowed to take this module to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 2 Students of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Surveying are allowed to take "GEE5103 Living with Sustainable Materials" to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester One, AY 2018/19.
- 3 Students of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Product Design are not allowed to take “GEE5107 Land Art” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2020/21.
- 4 Students of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Advertising / Digital Advertising are not allowed to take “GEE5107 Land Art” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester One, AY 2021/22.
- 5 GEE5109 offered by DDA (previously known as FDE) has been renamed from “Toy Design” to “Design for Fun” with effect from Semester One, AY 2022/23. Students who have taken the module “Toy Design” before Semester One, AY 2022/23 are not allowed to take the module “Design for Fun” to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 6 The arrangement for students of Multimedia Technology and Innovation, Information and Communications Technology and Surveying who take “GEE5305 The Art & Science of Film”, “GEE5308 Web Technology & E-commerce” and “GEE5309 Housing Policy & Management” are as follows: (a) For students who joined THEi in AY 2018/19, AY 2019/20 and AY 2020/21, these three GEE modules will be counted as delivered by DDA/DDIT (previously known as FDE); (b) For students who joined THEi in AY2017/18 or earlier, these modules will be counted as delivered by DCEE (previously known as FST).
- 7 The arrangement for students other than those of Multimedia Technology and Innovation, Information and Communications Technology and Surveying who take "GEE5305 The Art & Science of Film", "GEE5308 Web Technology & E-commerce" and "GEE5309 Housing Policy & Management" are as follows: (a) took the modules in AY 2017/18 or before; the modules were offered by DCEE/DHFS (previously known as FST); (b) took/took the modules in AY 2018/19 or after: the modules were/are offered by DDA/DDIT (previously known as FDE).
- 8 Students are allowed to either take “GEE5305 The Art & Science of Film” or “GEE5416 Beyond Hollywood: Introduction to World Cinema” but not both modules to fulfill the graduation requirement. “GEE5416 Beyond Hollywood: Introduction to World Cinema” was phased out in AY 2019/20.
- 9 Students of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Professional Accounting are not allowed to take “GEE5308 Web Technology & E-Commerce” to fulfill the graduation requirement with effect from the Year-1 and Year-3 entry cohorts of AY 2018/19. The students other than the above cohorts are allowed to take this module.
- 10 Students of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Health Care are allowed to take “GEE5203 Corporate Social Responsibility in Action” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester One, AY 2016/17.
- 11 Year 3 and Year 4 students of Recreation Management/Sports Management specialisation of Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Sports and Recreation Management Programme are not allowed to take “GEE5208 Accounting for Non-Accountants” and “GEE5210 Essentials in People Management” to fulfil the graduation requirement. These three GEE modules will not be counted for fulfilling graduation requirement for students of Recreation Management specialisation even they took the module(s) in their Year 1 and/or Year 2 study.
- 12 Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Public Relations and International Events Management who take “MCC5211 Human Resources Management” as programme elective are not allowed to take “GEE5210 Essentials in People Management” to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 13 Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Public Relations and International Events Management who take “MPM4200 Public Speaking” as programme core/elective are not allowed to take “GEE5213 The Art of Professional Speaking” to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 14 Students of Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) in Building Services Engineering are not allowed to take “GEE5323 Indoor Environmental Engineering” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2022/23.
- 15 Students of Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) in Civil Engineering are not allowed to take “GEE5324 Environmental Engineering” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2022/23.
- 16 Students are allowed to either take “GEE5304 Nutrition & Health” or “GEE5307 Food in Daily Life” but not both modules to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 17 Students of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Food Science and Safety are not allowed to take “GEE5325 Advanced Topics in Food Science” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2022/23.
- 18 Students of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Testing and Certification are not allowed to take “GEE5326 Gemological Science” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2022/23.
- 19 Students of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Chinese Medicinal Pharmacy are not allowed to take “GEE5327 中藥炮製學 (Processing of Chinese Materia Medica)” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2022/23.
- 20 Students of Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Nutrition and Healthcare Management are not allowed to take “GEE5328 Primary Health Care & Health Promotion” to fulfil the graduation requirement with effect from Semester Two, AY 2022/23.
- 21 "GEE5405" offered by SGEL has been renamed from “Modern Europe: History & Culture” to “The Modern World: History & Culture” with effect from Semester One, AY 2018/19. Students who had taken the module "Modern Europe: History & Culture" before Semester One, AY 2018/19 are not allowed to retake the module "The Modern World: History & Culture".
- 22 Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Public Relations and International Events Management who take “MPM5406 Translation for Public Relations” as programme elective are not allowed to take “GEE5407 Translation in Everyday Life (English-Chinese)” to fulfil the graduation requirement. This requirement also takes effect retrospectively to the cohorts of AY 2015/16 to AY 2019/20.
- 23 GEE5415 offered by SGEL has been renamed from “Cantonese in Hong Kong Popular Culture” to “從香港流行文化研究粵語語言學 (Cantonese Linguistics in Hong Kong Popular Culture)” with effect from Semester Two, AY 2018/19. Students who have taken the module "Cantonese in Hong Kong Popular Culture" before Semester Two, AY 2018/19 are not allowed to retake the module “從香港流行文化研究粵語語言學 (Cantonese Linguistics in Hong Kong Popular Culture)”.
- 24 GEE5426 Entrepreneurship in Action offered by SGEL is designed for students admitted via Year-3 entry. Students who take “GEC4306 Entrepreneurial Mindset” are not allowed to take “GEE5426 Entrepreneurship in Action” to fulfil the graduation requirement. This requirement also takes effect retrospectively to the cohorts of all THEi programmes starting from AY 2012/13.
- 25 Year 3 and Year 4 students of Recreation Management/Sports Management specialisation of Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Sports and Recreation Management who take “MCC5323 Entrepreneurship” are not allowed to take “GEE5426 Entrepreneurship in Action” to fulfil the graduation requirement. This requirement also takes effect retrospectively to the cohorts of AY 2012/13 to AY 2020/21.
- 26 Students of Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Sports Coaching who take MCC5323 Entrepreneurship as a Programme Elective Module are not allowed to take GEE5426 Entrepreneurship in Action to fulfil the graduation requirement
- 27 Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Public Relations and International Events Management who take “MCC5323 Entrepreneurship” as programme elective are not allowed to take “GEE5426 Entrepreneurship in Action” to fulfil the graduation requirement. This requirement also takes effect retrospectively to the cohorts of AY 2015/16 to AY 2020/21.
- 28 GEE5427 Technology & the Future of Work offered by SGEL is designed for students admitted via Year-3 entry. Students who take “GEC4305 Technology, Society & Work#” are not allowed to take “GEE5427 Technology & the Future of Work” to fulfil the graduation requirement. This requirement also takes effect retrospectively to the cohorts of all THEi programmes starting from AY 2012/13.
- 29 GEE5428K 從語言到生活：認識香港粵語與文化 (From Language to Daily Life: Understanding Hong Kong Cantonese & Culture) offered by SGEL is designed for students who are studying in Hong Kong with Putonghua (Mandarin/Chinese) as mother tongue. The module has been recoded from "GEE5428" to "GEE5428K" effective from Summer Semester, AY2024/25. Students who have taken the module GEE5428 before Summer Semester, AY2024/25 are not allowed to retake the module GEE5428K.
- 30 Students are allowed to either take “GEE5101 Effective Branding & Consumer Behaviour” or “GEE5101K 有效品牌與消費特性 (Effective Branding & Consumer Behaviour)” but not both modules to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 31 Students are allowed to either take “GEE5202 Wellness & Lifestyle Management” or “GEE5202J 身心健康與生活方式管理 (Wellness & Lifestyle Management)” but not both modules to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 32 Students are allowed to either take “GEE5429J 漢字歷史與日常生活 (Chinese Philology & Daily Life)” or “GEE5429K 漢字歷史與日常生活 (Chinese Philology & Daily Life)” but not both modules to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 33 GEE5430J/ GEE5430K 學術中文寫作及匯報技巧 (Academic Chinese Writing & Presentation Skills) is designed for students who are studying programmes of Chinese (Cantonese/ Putonghua) MOL. Students are allowed to either take GEE5430J or GEE5430K but not both modules to fulfil the graduation requirement.
- 34 Students are allowed to either take “GEE5209 Business Management in Hong Kong” or “GEE5209K 香港商業管理 (Business Management in Hong Kong)” but not both modules to fulfil the graduation requirement.
