

Notes to confirm the attendance in New Student Orientation Day 2026

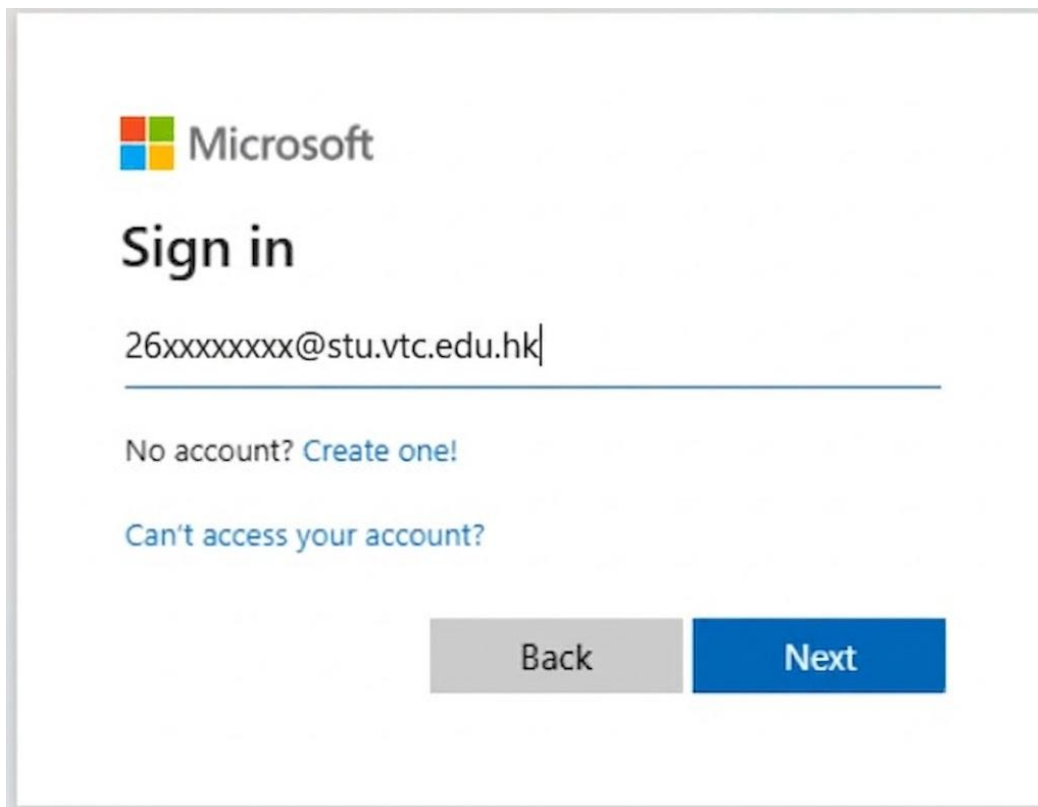
THEi students should confirm their attendance in the New Student Orientation Day 2026 for:

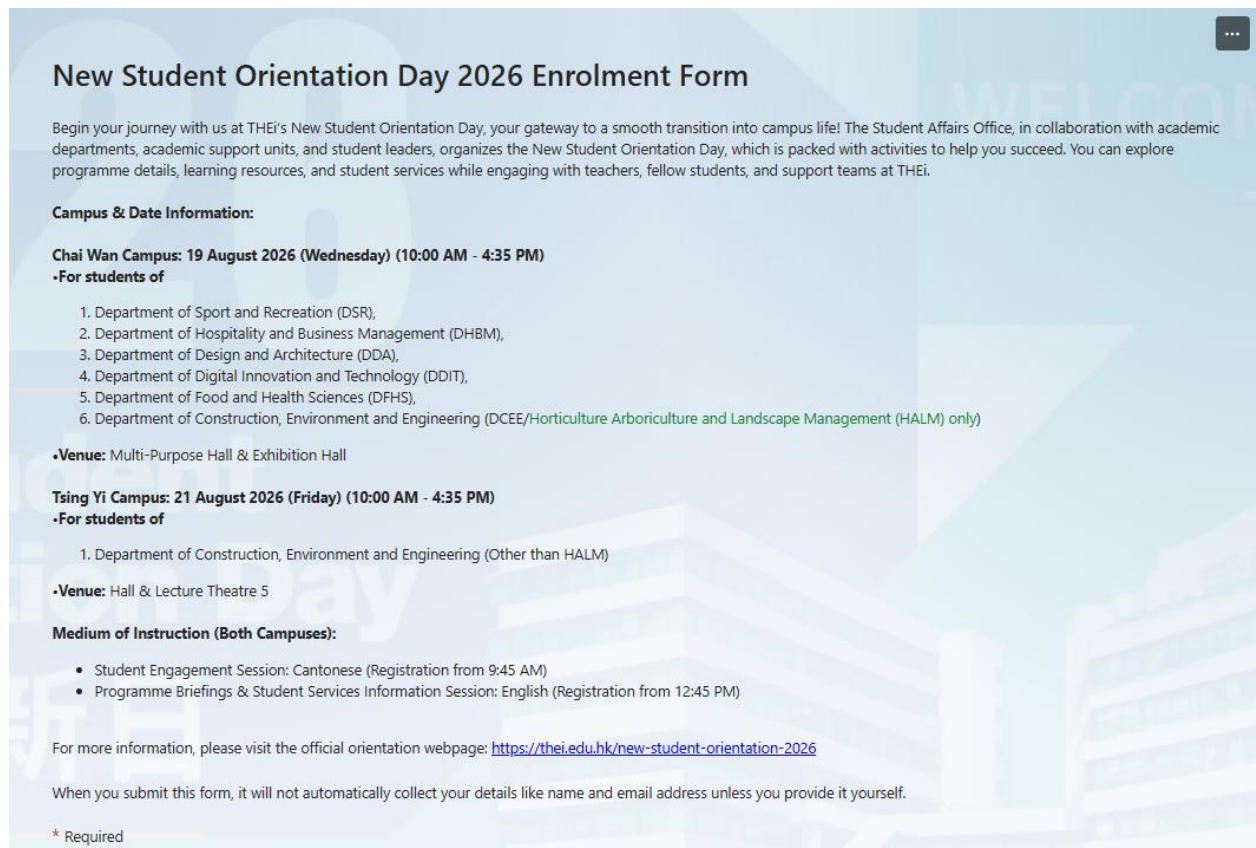

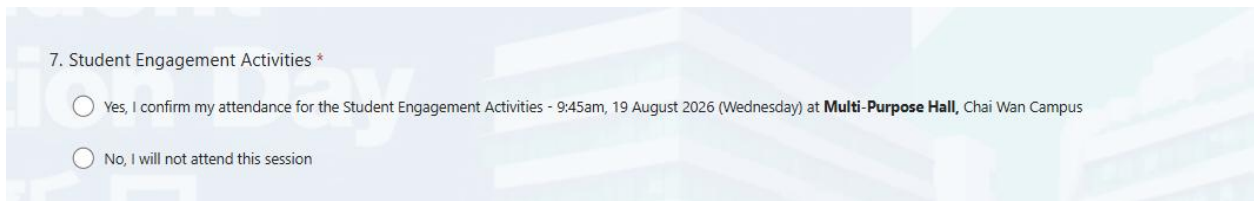

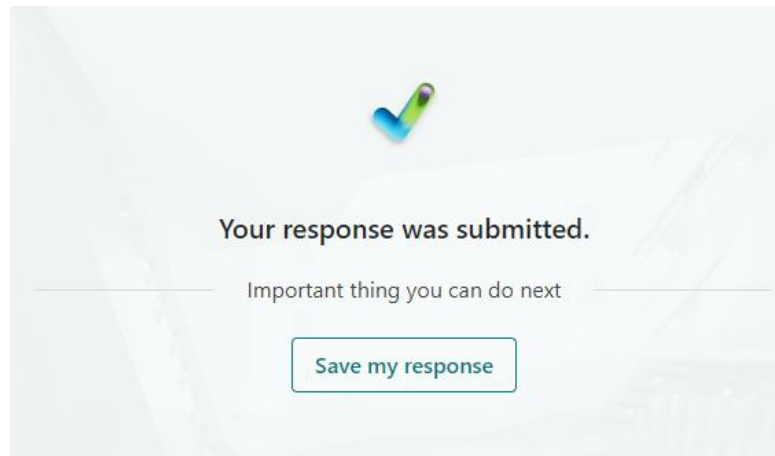
